



## Grades K1-2 Activities

**Zumba Kids:** Zumba is a really fun exercise and dance. It will begin with 10 minutes of stretching, 10 minutes of exercise balls, and 30 minutes of dance.

**Happy Childcare Club:** (*Grades K1 and K2 only*) Our intention is to entertain our little ones through diverse activities (physical and artistic). Children will find an opportunity to exercise, to have fun and to socialize.

**Taekwondo:** (*Grades 1 and 2 only*) Children will learn fundamental skills of Taekwondo from a beginner level, such as kicking and jumping. Students also learn principles of respect and concentration.

**Swimming:** (*Grades 1 and 2 only*) Children will learn basic strokes and stroke correction as well as familiarity with the water. Students provide their own swimming costume, goggles, towel and a swim cap. Students ride a TCIS bus to and from the pool and will be chaperoned by TCIS staff. All swimming levels are welcome to attend.

**Jump Rope:** (*Grade 2 only*) Students learn and practice both short and long jump rope skills and tricks. All ability levels welcome.

**Ball Skills:** (*Grades 1 and 2 only*) Students will play, practice and learn the fundamentals of many different ball sports, including basketball, baseball and football. Priority will be given to those students who have demonstrated excellent behavior in previous activity sessions.

**Ballet:** (*Grades 1 and 2 only*) All ability levels are welcome to come learn. Those signing up should bring their own ballet shoes and clothes.

**Board Games:** Students will choose their favorite games and learn some new ones. Everyone welcome!

**Chess Club:** (*Grades K2-2nd only*) Students will learn and improve their skills, through game play and practice. All ability levels are welcome.

**Chinese Club:** (*Grades K2-2nd*) Your children will know Chinese Culture, cook Chinese food, learn Chinese words, songs, basic conversation, etc. They will learn Chinese through different games and activities.

**Elementary Choir:** Participants will learn the basic of choral singing while preparing for winter and spring performances.

**Lego Club:** Students will build, create and have fun with Lego! If interested, students may create Lego animation movies. Priority will be given to those students who have demonstrated excellent behavior in previous activity sessions.

**Arts and Crafts Club:** (*Grades 1 and 2 only*) The aim of the art and craft club is to allow the students to get the experience and enjoy different aspects of art and design work such as paper and glue crafts, recycled crafts, bottle arts, and making paper flowers, etc.

**French Club:** (*Grade 2 only*) Bonjour! In French Club, we will be focusing on the language and culture of France and other French-speaking countries. We will learn about the history, traditions, and literature of these countries and celebrate the French culture through traditional French music, games, and food.

**Yarn Craft Club (뜨개질):** We will be learning knitting / crochet to make Christmas ornaments and little things for everyday use.

## Grades 3-5 Activities

**Ultimate Dodgeball Games:** This will most likely be the best movement based activity for your young child to exert energy, dodge, dip, duck and HAVE FUN!

**Dance (Jazz):** Jazz dancing is a form of dance that showcases a dancer's individual style and originality. Every jazz dancer interprets and executes moves and steps in their own way. **Praise and Worship Team:** Students will sing and practice songs to lead the elementary students during chapel times, which are every Day 6. Enthusiasm is required and singing/dancing skills are a bonus! All abilities are welcome.

**Science Club:** Students will get to explore various dynamics of science as they do experiments. Hands-on, interactive learning!

**Elementary Symphony:** (*Grades 3 and 4 only*) Beginning band and strings (options: flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, trombone, euphonium, violin, viola, or cello). String players must be taking private lessons to participate in this ensemble since the instructor only has a band background. We would like to give beginning string players an opportunity to play in an ensemble.

**Drama Club:** We are preparing for the Christmas play, new students can still participate but will have a non-speaking / non singing part.

**Lego Club:** Students will build, create and have fun with Lego! If interested students may create Lego animation movies. Priority will be given to those students who have demonstrated excellent behavior in previous activity sessions.

**Elementary Choir:** Participants will learn the basics of choral singing while preparing for winter and spring performances.
